## Ft Myers woman charged in murder-for-hire plot

FORT MYERS, FL - A Fort Myers woman was arrested Tuesday after investigators say she paid an undercover detective to murder her husband.

Bettina Desiree Meixel, 40, was booked into the Lee County Jail on a charge of premeditated first-degree murder for conspiring to commit the crime.

On Sept. 8, the Lee County Sheriff's Office received information regarding Meixel seeking someone to kill her husband Jason Meixel, according to an incident report.

A day later an undercover detective, posing as a hitman, met with her at a sports bar, where she agreed to pay him \$500 on Sept. 13 and then \$4,500 in the form of her husband's Limited Edition Harley Davidson motorcycle afterward, according to the Lee County Sheriff's Office.

During the meeting she agreed to provide a photo of her husband along with additional information needed to commit the murder, the report said.

On Tuesday afternoon, investigators say she handed over the cash and information, including details of her husband's daily activity, confirmed the details of the murder, then left the meeting in her car.

Minutes later deputies stopped and took her into custody without incident.

## ARTICLE IV - Officers


