Greetings to you in the name of the Risen Christ! It is time to reenroll in the Master Inservice Program that begins July 1, and ends June 30. An enrollment form is available on our website at:

For those of you who have opted not to enroll, you might want to re think that decision considering the following:

**Key Points of Importance**

1. The MIP includes verification of and record keeping for inservice hours earned toward:
  - State of Florida Teacher Recertification
  - CDA Update Credits
  - Inservice for Custodial, Food Service, etc. employees
2. The MIP is **the official process** for initial State of Florida teacher certification. If teachers in NLSA or Florida-Georgia District accredited schools are to become certified in Florida, the MIP is **the only** process to be followed.
3. Initial Teacher Certification and Recertification is **only** for teachers who serve in NLSA or Florida-Georgia District accredited schools.
4. The CDA and all other employee inservice credit programs are available to ALL schools, regardless of their accreditation status.

Please note that the fees listed on the enrollment form may not be consistent with the fees listed in the letter that was sent out by Dr. Morris. The fees on the enclosed form are **correct**.

If you have any problems with the way the program is conducted, please don't hesitate to let me know about them. I want this program to serve you and your staff members well. Let's work together to make that happen. God's richest blessings to you as you enter the "home stretch" for this school year.
