

LIBRARY POLICY STATEMENT

1. The purpose of the library

The Florida-Georgia District library exists to provide theological and practical resources for the use of the District staff and for the rostered church workers of the District.

2. Clientele of the library

The library is available for the use of the professional staff of the Florida-Georgia District of the Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod and for the use of rostered church workers of the District in preparation for presentations at conferences and professional gatherings, as well as for individual study.

3. The book collection

The collection emphasizes Biblical studies (including commentaries), systematic theology, church history (early church, medieval period, the Reformation, American Lutheran history), worship, and pastoral theological concerns (including ethics). Items of ephemeral interest are not added to the collection because of the limited amount of space available for the library.

4. Access to the collection

Any person is welcome to use the facilities without borrowing privileges and may register as a full user with borrowing rights when authorized by the librarian. Books that are to be borrowed must be signed out and are to be returned within one month after borrowing.
