

NLSA Routes to Accreditation
Effective September 1, 2018

As of September 1, 2018, Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod schools will have four options when looking to complete the National Lutheran School Accreditation (NLSA) process. Review each option below and work with your NLSA District Commissioner and assigned school Consultant to determine which one will best serve your ministry.

¹ A school completing Option C will need to have a single Validation Team visit with no fewer than 8 team members distributed accordingly to evaluate each program and Self-Study document.

² Duplicate certificates may be requested to hang in offices on multiple campuses.

³ If the Validation Team Report for either Self-Study process recommends “Provisional” status, the entire school’s Accreditation will reflect this as an overall status until resolved.

⁴ A school completing Option C will need to meet the School of Distinction requirements for both the EBA and EC processes to be considered for School of Distinction recognition.
