- Lord Jesus, we praise You for Your unfathomable love, which carried You to the cross for us and all people. Let the fire of Your love ignite our hearts and move us to loving action for all we meet today.

- Ask God to bless the Missionary Pathway cohorts currently underway. Pray that participants are equipped to share Jesus where they live, work, and play.
- Every person in the FLGA District would see themselves as an Along-Sider, bringing Jesus' joy to their neighbors and friends. Pray that the Holy Spirit will show them someone they can disciple as a disciple-maker.
- Pray the Holy Spirit will shepherd the process of exploring and planning for new Lutheran schools in multiple locations throughout the District.
- Pray for Campus Pastors Jay Winters (University Lutheran, Tallahassee), John Roth (Thrive, Estero), and Greg Michael (Christus Victor, Athens) as they share the Gospel with students on campus who face fears, doubts, and worries.

- Ask the Lord of the Harvest to give wisdom and creativity to congregations who want to begin new outreach ministries in their communities.
- Ask the Lord to open our eyes and hearts to the opportunities to start new ministries and outreach among 60,000 new residents moving into Florida each month.

- Pray for our Early Childhood ministries that introduce young children and their families to Jesus. Pray that their witness to God's children will reach families and communities through our Lutheran Schools.
- Pray that young people will hunger for the truth of the Gospel and not be deceived by the half-truths and lies of the Evil One.
- Palm Sunday: give thanks for Jesus, who endured the cross for you, and who is now seated at the right hand of the Father in glory. Ask Jesus to give you the Joy of Salvation during Holy Week.
- Give thanks that Jesus had you on His mind as He suffered and died on the cross. Ask that His love will fill your heart and lead you to love others.
- Ask the Holy Spirit to pour out the joy of salvation, of knowing Jesus as our Savior, and of living as His forgiven, loved, and restored disciples.
- Ask that the Holy Spirit connect us with people who are open to the Gospel's message and that God would keep our eyes open daily for people with whom we can share God's love in Jesus.
- 28 Maundy Thursday: thousand, thousand thanks shall be, Dearest Jesus, unto Thee! Thank you Jesus, for Your Body and Blood, given and shed for our life and salvation!
- Good Friday: ask forgiveness for those times we have allowed conflict to give a negative witness in our families, congregations, and Synod.
- Holy Saturday: ask the Holy Spirit for opportunities today to engage in spiritual conversations and the sense to notice those opportunities along with the wisdom and courage to speak for Him.
- BASTER SUNDAY: He lives! All glory to His name! He lives my Jesus, still the same; Oh, the sweet joy this sentence gives: I know that my Redeemer lives! Hallelujah!
