Our missional God has reached nations on His agenda from the very beginning... His command to Abraham is to "Get up and Go!"

As an extension of His blessing, we get up and go knowing that the Sender has the desire for us to be in His service. Perhaps, the church, the body of Christ on earth, is having such challenging times because we are busy doing many things, saving lots of money, and avoiding the ethnic groups around us instead of going in accord with the command of our Heavenly Father, the Sender, to our earthly father, Abram, the sent one. We are to be going, blessing others, being a blessing, and introducing those in our world to the God who loves them to the degree that He willingly, even joyfully, sacrifices everything necessary to bring the nations to Himself, including His only begotten son, Jesus.

Please note this most important element of the narrative. There is no indication that Abram had any special training or degrees. The text does not indicate that Abram is a linguistic expert who will understand every language and culture. Our Father is interested in Abram being obedient to the call "Get up and go!"

Our Father sometimes sends those who are equipped to go, but He always, without fail, equips those who are send as they are going. Get up, dear saints! Let's go, anointed of our Father. You are being sent! The great, all-powerful, loving, and resurrected God of all Creation goes before you; He has given you all His blessings to share, love to impart, and relationship with Him for this world that does not know Him. Let's go!

Father, thank You for Your consistent message for us, that You are sending us to GO and disciple people for your sovereign purposes to advance Your Kingdom... Send us Your Holy Spirit, Father, to breathe on us and inspire us as we GO in accordance with Your will and Your command. Come on Jesus, come on Holy Spirit, bless us to get up and go. Amen.

Forgive us for our lack of awareness of those around us who need to hear Jesus' message of Good News, of not noticing those on the margins who need the welcome of our Savior.


