GOD SPEAKS

READ ACTS 16;25-40

Then [the Jailer] brought them out and said, "Sirs, what must I do to be saved?" And they said, "Believe on the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved..." (Acts 16:30f)

"What must I do to be saved?" the Jailer asked. Rightly translated, Paul and Silas' response is a bit unexpected. "Believe ON the Lord Jesus" they say. This is quite different from believing IN the right thoughts, actions, and feelings about Jesus. In other words, Paul and Silas call to the Jailer is to believe ON Jesus' life, death, and resurrection. They're speaking of freedom for the captor who is captive in his sin. It's Jesus Who is for you, for your family, and for all imprisoned souls!

Belief is trust, not in principles, but on a Person. Belief is faith, not in rules, but on a Ruler. Belief is conviction, not in experiences, but on an encounter with the living God. With a mind opened to believe ON Jesus, the Jailer is converted from his captivity to sin and invited into the family of God. It is here that he and his household are baptized IN Christ Jesus!

See how his life mission changes, from minding a prison designed for punishment to a home filled with hospitality, joy, and love? With our minds opened to believe we become believers IN God as we believe ON Jesus. Together we can move confidently with the Spirit form our baptism into His mission, to God's glory and the expansion of His Kingdom!

Lord God, You know the prisons of our making and all our feeble attempts to free ourselves from the chains of sin. Come, Holy Spirit, take our thoughts captive to Christ. Come, Holy Spirit, make our actions reflections of gratitude. Come, Holy Spirit, shake our complacent beliefs with faith in the gracious encounter of Christ. Help us to believe ON Jesus, and thus to believe IN You. May Your glorious mission, to free all people in Christ, become our own mission as we seek to open our minds and our homes to Your healing power. May Your peace, O God, which surpasses all understanding, guard our hearts and minds in Christ Jesus. Amen.



- Pray for Missionary Lophane Laurent, Mission Haiti. Pray for protection, both physical and spiritual, and pray for God to provide the needed funds for monthly food distribution.
- Pray for elected leaders in our FLGA District, Vice Presidents Jeff Jordan, Jay Winters, Charles Reich, David Brockhoff, and Scott Henze, District Secretary Greg Michael, and our Board of Directors, that God will bless their mission leadership.
- Ask that God bless the vision and work of President Rockey and his staff, our Circuit Visitors, pastors, and local church leaders who understand the purpose of the Church and take mission seriously in these times.

- Ask God to inspire the hearts of His people in all our congregations to mission action this summer, especially noting opportunities to plant the Church in new places with new people.
