For more than 75 years, God has been on a mission through the people and ministries of the Florida-Georgia District. From the District’s inception, we have sought to respond to the working of the Spirit to fulfill the Lord’s command to “go and make disciples”. This faithful commitment to living as His witnesses has spurred on our district to grow from 22 founding missional congregations to nearly 200 congregations with more than 35,000 people today.

Today, just as 75 years ago, many people are living without hope and joy. And, perhaps even more urgently, people are living separated from God for eternity. As those captured by the grace of God, we must remember that our faith is for sharing so more people can experience the Lord’s salvation. When we fail to share our relationship with Christ, we fail to love our neighbors and abandon them to a life separated from God. And that cannot stand.

Moving forward, we will continue to equip, empower, and engage the congregations and the individuals of the Florida-Georgia District. And as we do, we see the District’s role in this season being focused on equipping congregations to help individual believers become reacquainted with the hope of their salvation and the joy of life with God.

Between now and 2030 our greatest opportunity as a district is to reactivate the evangelical potential of the disciples already in our congregations so that every niece and neighbor, every brother and business associate can experience the life-giving salvation of our God. We are a people compelled by Christ’s love to see those lost, confused and hurting in this dark day find the One source of peace, hope and true life that is unchanging!

In the coming years, corporate worship and vital community in our congregations will remain foundational in our life and mission together. Yet it’s not all about us. As the Church, the “called-out ones”, greater focus will surround relationships and engaging our communities “out” where people are. - Promote a process for congregations to understand the demographics of their community and assess community needs and assets
- Guide congregations in aligning congregational strengths with community needs and assets to evaluate opportunities to serve the community
- Help congregations identify and act on opportunities for multiplication
- Collect and share stories of congregations' work in their communities

4. Foster a Sense of Shared District Identity

- Establish consistent language in communication to congregations and members
